



## Spring Session March 6 - April 20 2017



Registration opens at your school office 8am Tuesday, February 28 and closes at 3:30pm on Friday, March 3rd or as classes fill. See class descriptions for dates, times, and cost.

Please pay separately for each class. Make checks payable to PGUSD.

Registration deadline is Friday, March 3rd but classes can fill prior to deadline. Classes are kept at manageable size with minimum and maximum enrollment to ensure the best experience for all participants. Enrollment is based on date/time stamp of registration receipt. Confirmations will not be sent.

*Plan to begin classes on March 6th unless you are notified your enrollment request cannot be accommodated.*

If your child is enrolled in BASRP, please notify them when you enroll your child in ASE courses. Please pick up your child promptly after classes. Children not picked up promptly at the end of class will be taken to BASRP (daycare) and you will be charged.

Bus transportation is offered to take FG students to RHD Mon/Tues/Wed to attend ASE classes. Please complete Bus Pass application and submit with registration. Transportation makes every effort to arrive on time, however unexpected bus demands can occur that will affect getting your child to class in a timely manner.

**Monday, March 6th - April 17 (No class on April 10 due to Spring Break)**

**Mixed Media Art Lab** (gr 3-5) ELLEN BERRAHMOUN 3:20 - 4:50 **RHD Rm 18** \$80

Join us for a mixed media class packed with exciting projects and interesting art materials! Over 6 weeks we'll explore pop-up adventure books, graffiti style lettering, robot art, paper sculpture, 3D model making and more. Bring your creativity and be prepared to sculpt, paint, draw and invent!

**S.T.E.A.M.** (gr 4-5) ANDREW BRADLEY **RHD Computer lab** \$70

Using a S.T.E.A.M. curriculum, which combines Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics, students will participate in practical experiments, challenging group projects, and friendly competitions. We will learn coding, 3D design and printing, and much more! We will work as teams to solve complex problems and untangle complicated puzzles.

**Tuesday, March 7 - April 18 (No class on April 11 due to Spring Break)**

**Chess** (gr 2-5) DAVID PEELO **RHD Library** \$70

The game of chess is over 1300 years old and is one of the most popular games in the world! Learn basic skills, develop strategy, and practice game etiquette.

**Theater Arts** (gr 3-5) "*Improv*" MARIA DAWSON 3:20 - 4:45 **RHD Auditorium** \$80

Comedy "Improv" is a form of theater where most or all of what is created is performed by the players "on the spot". You will learn to think on your feet, listen and respond, tell stories, and have fun! No experience necessary.

**Wednesday, March 8 - April 19 (No class on April 12 due to Spring Break)**

**Yoga** (gr 3-5) RITIKA KUMAR **RHD Cafeteria** \$70

Come join for a playful, non-competitive yoga experience to promote coordination, flexibility, focus, balance and mindfulness. This class will focus on helping kids practice gentle movements in a fun way.

**Theater Arts** (gr 1-2) "*Creative Play*" MARIA DAWSON **RHD Auditorium** 3:15-4pm \$70

This process-based class will focus on theatre skills, imagination, self-expression, movement, stage presence, vocal exercises and FUN!

**Kindness Counts** (gr 1-5) JULIANNA McDONOUGH **FG** \$70

We will have fun exploring kindness, what it means to be kind, and how we can help others. Children will have the opportunity to reflect on the impact of kindness, and participate in team building crafts and activities.

**Thursday, March 9 - April 20 (No class on April 13 due to Spring Break)**

**Ceramics** (gr 3-5) RITIKA KUMAR **RHD Project Room** \$70

In this class, kids will learn the basic methods of hand building such as Coiling, Pinching, Building with slab and sculpting clay. Finished artwork will be glazed and fired up in the kiln.

**Creativity 101** (gr 1-2) JULIE HEILMAN **RHD Rm E2** \$70

Colored pencils, pastels, watercolors, and clay are some of the mediums we will explore with each week. Fundamental instruction will be provided with the focus on process vs. product. The fun of creativity is the number one rule!

She has many years of art teaching experience in school, afterschool, summer camp and community settings over the past 20 plus years besides being a professional musician. **Andrew Bradley** is the Computer Lab Instructor at Robert Down. With this class, he would like to bring our ASE students a challenging after-school program that will include something to pique the talents and interests of every student. Fellow RHD parent, **Ritika Kumar** will be teaching yoga and ceramics. She is a certified children's yoga teacher and an art teacher who is passionate about engaging kids in the magic of clay.

**David Peelo** is retired from service with the US Marine Corps and the CHP, and volunteers as a tutor at RHD. He believes that chess is an enjoyable way for children to develop critical thinking ability. Peninsula artist **Julie Heilman** teaches classes at the PG Art Center. She encourages children to use creativity to discover their artistic voice. **Maria Dawson** offers a wealth of education and experience as an actor and drama teacher in many Peninsula performance and education venues. Another RHD parent, **Julianna McDonough** will be taking what our kids learned during Kindness week and extending those positive ideas into their everyday lives.
