Registration opens at your school's front office at 8am on Monday, February 26, and closes at 4pm on Friday, March 9th, or as classes fill. Please see class descriptions for dates, times, and cost.

Please pay separately for each class. Make checks payable to PGUSD. If paying with cash, please have exact amount.

The registration deadline is Friday, March 9th, yet classes can fill prior to this deadline. Classes are kept at manageable size with minimum and maximum enrollment to ensure the best experience for all participants. Enrollment is based on date/time stamp of registration receipt. Confirmations will be sent via email the week prior to classes beginning.

Plan to begin classes on March 12th unless you are notified your enrollment request cannot be accommodated.

If your child is enrolled in BASRP, please notify them when you enroll your child in ASE courses. Please pick up your child promptly after classes. Children not picked up promptly at the end of class will be taken to BASRP (daycare) and you will be charged.

Complimentary bus transportation is offered to take students on Mon/Tues/Wed to attend ASE classes. Please complete the Bus Pass application and submit with registration. Transportation makes every effort to arrive on time, however unexpected bus demands can occur that will affect getting your child to class in a timely manner.

Monday, March 12th - April 23(No class on April 9 due to Spring Break)

Shadow Puppetry (grades 3 - 5) ELLEN BERRAHMOUN **RHD Room 16** \$75

In this exciting class, our class will explore the magic of shadow puppetry - combining visual art, storytelling and drama. Students will learn about the ancient origins of shadow puppets and view some modern examples; then develop their own stories, create shadow puppet characters, and design colorful background scenery. Next, they will add dialogue, movement, lights, and sound effects. Finally.... show time!

STEM Challenge with LEGO® (grades 3 - 5) ASPEN LAWLER **FG Room G-4** \$90

Tuesday, March 13 - April 24(No class on April 10 due to Spring Break)

Creativity 101 (grades 1 - 2) JULIE HEILMAN **RHD Room 7** \$75

Colored pencils, pastels, watercolors, and clay are some of the mediums we will explore with each week. Fundamental instruction will be provided with the focus on process vs. product. The fun of creativity is the number one rule!

Ceramics (grades 3 - 5) RITIKA KUMAR **FG Room E -1** \$75

Wednesday, March 14 - April 25 (No class on April 11 due to Spring Break)

Theater Arts (grades 1 - 2) "Creative Play" MARIA DAWSON **RHD Ottertorium 3:10 - 4:05** \$60

This process-based class will focus on theatre skills, imagination, self-expression, movement, stage presence, vocal exercises and FUN!

Ceramics (grades 3 - 5) RITIKA KUMAR **RHD Room D-1** \$75

Yoga (grades 1 - 5) RITIKA KUMAR **RHD Room 7** \$60

Come join for a playful, non-competitive yoga experience to promote coordination, flexibility, focus, balance and mindfulness. This class will focus on helping kids practice gentle movements in a fun way.

Ukulele - Level 2 (grades 4 & 5) LISA LAVIN **FG Room K-5** \$60

Prerequisite is to complete Ukulele I, or to demonstrate basic ability of of tuning and basic strumming of the following chords: C, Am, F, G.
