Thank you again for your continued support and patience.

We have breaking news from Monterey County Supervisors. As you may have heard, **the county will be placed into “shelter in place” effective midnight tonight, for three weeks until midnight on April 8, 2020.** We will give you more information as we learn more, but in the meantime, this means that the District Office and all school sites will be closed and our employees will work remotely from home. However, we do ask that you please limit communications to the District on an emergency basis until Friday, March 20 while we respond to this new county directive.

We anticipate sending you an update earlier than usual tomorrow morning as information becomes available. There are many unanswered questions at this time and we hope to have those answers in our morning update.
